The Board approved the location of the shed. Tom is going to pass that information along to Russ and James.
- June 15th is going to be the Kick off to Summer party down at the park. It's going to be a beach party with a live band, bounce house and many activities for the kids. All are welcome to this free event.

D. COALITION UPDATE

Evan Dantos has been to two Coalition meetings since our last P&R meeting.
