REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF LAST MEETING'S MINUTES

ON A MOTION BY AnneMarie Cox, seconded by Donna Snyder, the Board voted (5-0-0) to accept the minutes of May 9, 2012 as written.

GRANBY PREVENTION COUNCIL UPDATE:

- The brochure is done.
- The PowerPoint presentation is almost done. The group is deciding who will make phone calls and who will do the presentations.
- The council had a table at the Taste of Granby.
- A calendar of next year's events is being put together.
- There will be another health fair at the high school next year.
- Wayne Kowal from the CT State Police Narcotics Task Force will do an in-school presentation and a presentation to parents in the evening.
- The Department of Education grants are due September 1st.

YOUTH COUNSELOR REPORT:

- The two new interns have started.
- GO (Guys Only) will be held over the summer. There are some East Granby kids who participate in the group.
- Planning for next year has begun.
- Ms. Cox will be at the middle school a few hours a week.
- There will be a group for middle school girls for Granby and East Granby.
- A meeting was held with the East Granby Superintendent. The Search Institute survey will be administered in the fall.

YOUTH ACTION COUNCIL:

- YAC has ended for the year.
- A weekend retreat at Camp Jewel is being considered for the end of August.
- Presently, there are slots open for two freshmen and one sophomore. Recommendations for those slots have been received and the letters will be sent out.

- Two YAC members will attend this meeting next year and one member will attend the GPC. If they can't make a meeting, it is their responsibility to find coverage.

- Ms. Cox would like to create a committee to look into the details of getting a bus to provide transportation for after school activities, i.e. cost, etc.
- Captain Tyler reported that an alcohol compliance check was conducted the week of May 21st. He explained the process in which an underage decoy attempts to purchase alcohol. There are six retailers in Granby and no one sold to the individual. Typically, there is a 15% failure rate. All of the retailers were contacted with the results and a press release was done in the Patch.
