

HOT SHOT BASKETBALL SHOOTING CONTEST



This is a statewide contest run annually by the CT. Parks & Recreation Association. The purpose is to promote basketball enthusiasm as well as basketball skills, fun, physical fitness and good sportsmanship.

Each player will have one minute to shoot from “hotspots” placed on one half of the court. The contest challenges a player’s speed, shooting, dribbling and rebounding ability. Three one-minute rounds constitute the duration of play for each player. The top scorer in each division will move on to the next (County) level of the contest.
