

**Town of Granby****MAINTAINER II**  
(Public Works)**OBJECTIVES**

Under the general direction of a Public Works Foreman, performs semi-skilled and some skilled work in the construction, reconstruction, repair and maintenance of Town roads, storm sewers, landfill, and parks. Operates truck and light equipment. May lead Maintainer I's as assigned.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

Drives truck and crew to job site, and operates heavy truck in hauling gravel, sand, fill, and asphalt to job site.

Operates equipment to sweep streets, to mow fields, and roadsides, and maintain Town roads, grounds and facilities.

Performs work in the laying of pipe, repair, replacement and cleaning of catch basins, patching or resurfacing roads, and related maintenance tasks including building and grounds, and park maintenance.

Digs trenches, lays pipe, cleans catch basins and removes brush and debris.

Performs custodial maintenance and semi-skilled work in the repair and maintenance of Town, park and recreation facilities including painting facilities, planting trees, grass, and shrubbery, and lining athletic fields.

Performs sewer maintenance tasks as assigned.

Maintains and makes minor repairs to equipment and reports serious malfunctions to Mechanic.

Operates trucks and equipment to plow snow and sands roads, parking lots and other areas as assigned.

Regularly performs tasks of a Maintainer of lower grade including performing heavy physical labor.

Performs work following safety procedures and policies.

May be assigned to be on call as required.

Performs related work as required.

### REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of and the ability operate light construction equipment and drive a truck at a high skill level following safety procedures.

Basic knowledge of public works projects related to the construction, repair, and maintenance of Town roads, bridges, grounds, storm sewers, landfill areas, and facilities.

Knowledge of and the ability to perform routine maintenance of equipment and make minor repairs and adjustments.

Ability to work following oral directions.

Ability to maintain athletic fields and to install and maintain athletic equipment.

Ability to plow snow.

Ability to work in poor weather conditions and extreme temperatures.

Ability to perform heavy physical labor.

### REQUIRED EQUIPMENT OPERATION

Operates the following required equipment, including but not limited to: heavy truck, light equipment, sweeper, mower, snow plow, sander, etc. chain saw, small air and electric tools, etc.

### REQUIRED PHYSICAL EFFORT

Must lift heavy equipment in accordance with State and Federal guidelines and have ability to drive heavy equipment in bad weather. Must have excellent physical ability, stamina and coordination to protect the safety of himself and others. Must be able to stand for long periods of time to shovel, haul and load.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS (Minimum)

The qualifications required would generally be acquired with two years of experience performing successfully the duties of a Public Works Maintainer I or comparable work outside the Town. OR an equivalent combination of experience and training.
