

# how to dispose of OTHER ITEMS



## LEAF + YARD DEBRIS

Compost or accepted at the Granby Transfer Station. Leaves are free, yard debris is charged per load.



## FOOD SCRAPS

Compost food scraps. If you do not compost, all food waste goes in the trash.



## PLASTIC BAGS + FILM

Take bags/film that are clean and dry to a collection box at a local store.



## TEXTILES

Dry, odorless textiles (even torn, stained, & non-apparel items like sheets) can be recycled in any textile collection container



## HAZARDOUS WASTE

Three hazardous waste collections are held yearly. Call DPW 860-844-5241 for information.



## SHARPS

Place needles & lancets in a hard plastic container, seal, and label as "SHARPS". Place in the trash.



## MEDICATIONS

Put in the trash or bring them to the drop-off box at the Simsbury Police Station.



## E-WASTE

Accepted at the Granby Transfer Station free of charge.



## SCRAP METAL

Accepted at the Granby Transfer Station, fees apply.



## FOAM

Check with a local shipping store to see if they accept peanuts. Otherwise, they go in the trash.



## HARDCOVER BOOKS + MEDIA

Donate to a local book sale or place in the donation box at the Granby Transfer Station.



## COOKING OIL

Fats, oils, and grease should never go down the drain. Can be brought to Granby DPW for recycling.



## BULKY WASTE

Accepted at the Granby Transfer Station, fees apply



## REMODELING DEBRIS

Accepted at the Granby Transfer Station, fees apply.



## HYBRIDS

Items are not recyclable. Find special programs at [terracycle.net](http://terracycle.net) or place in the trash.
