

Voting Rights for Granby Town Referenda

Granby residents are permitted to vote in Town Referenda (other than a regular or special town election) if they are registered voters in the Town of Granby **or** are 18 years of age or older who, jointly or severally, is liable to the town for taxes assessed against him on the assessment of not less than \$1,000.00 on the last completed grand list.

Current State of Connecticut Election Laws requires that **all** voters be citizens of the United States with respect to Town Referenda votes as well as municipal, state and federal elections.

These requirements are contained in the State of Connecticut Election Laws Section 7-6 [Title 7 – Municipalities; Chapter 90 Town or Other Community Meetings].
