

Voting Eligibility Requirements for Municipal, State, or Federal Elections

In order to register to vote in the State of Connecticut, a person must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Be a United States citizen;
- Be a resident of a Connecticut town;
- Be at least 17 years old (must turn 18 before Election Day)
- Have completed confinement and parole (if previously convicted of a felony) and have had voting rights restored by the Registrar of Voters.

The above voting eligibility requirements apply to any municipal, state, or federal election.
